Number of people willing to become owners of the personal land in every county depended not only on their personal preferences, but also on the way of life in a particular area (the features of land tenure and land use, the development of commodity sectors of agriculture, national composition, population density, and the nature and level of "waste" on earnings, resettlement, attitude of "peace" to the allotment and so on). In total, significant role in privatization process was played by District Commanders.
